Some people are not kind



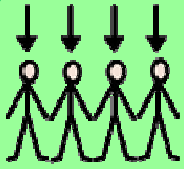
Some websites and videos are upsetting.

Remember your password.



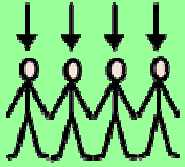
Don't tell people your password.



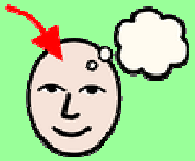
Breaking computers is not ok.

The internet is for everyone to use.



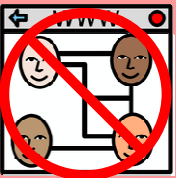
The internet is for learning.

Talk to adults you trust about what you do on the internet.



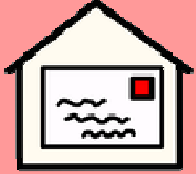

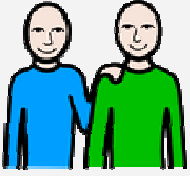
Be careful about sharing some information:

Phones and Music Players



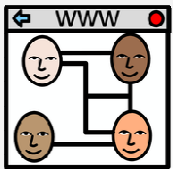
It is ok to bring phones and music players in to school.

Don't use phones at school.



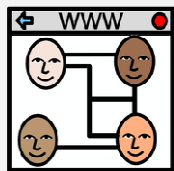
Social Networking Sites



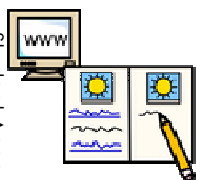
Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and Google Plus are social networking sites.

Lots of people can see the photos or stories you post.

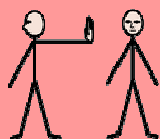
It is not ok to post photos or stories that:

Use racist or homophobic words

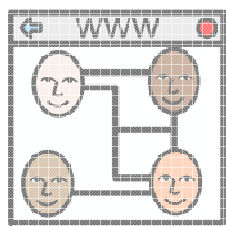
