Life Skills - Staged Tasks

| I can do the laundry | I can make drinks for people in my house | I can make sure my bed has clean sheets | I can make a snack / simple meal |
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| (1) Separate clothes into light and dark colours. | (5) Ask everyone in your house if they would like a drink. Write down what they would like. | (8) Strip the sheets and duvet covers from your bed. | (11) Choose the food items you want |
| (2) Wash a pile of clothes in the washing machine. Make sure an adult is supervising | (6) Make everyone a drink Make sure an adult is supervising if you are using a kettle | (9) Put the sheets and duvet covers in the laundry basket. | (12) Choose the equipment you need to make your snack |
