

Kennel Lane School: Provider Access

Introduction

This statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to learners at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Pupil entitlement

All learners in years 7-14 are entitled to:

- To find out about appropriate and relevant technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including appropriate and relevant technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events.
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of appropriate and relevant academic and technical courses.

Baker Clause Statement

This policy statement sets out Kennel Lane School's arrangements for managing the access of providers to Learners at school for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer.
